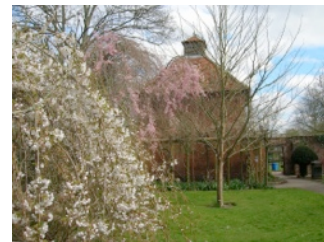
## Join the Supporters

Eastcote House and most of the outbuildings were demolished in 1964, leaving only the Stables, Dovecote and Walled Garden. These Grade II Listed structures are now on the English Heritage 'Buildings at Risk Register'. Currently, in conjunction with the London Borough of Hillingdon, the FEHG are seeking Heritage Lottery Funding to restore the buildings and make them available for community use, adding another building to house a Tea Room and toilets.
